



Communiqué: Aboriginal Leadership Group

Meeting 24: Wednesday 20 May and Thursday 21 May 2026

The Aboriginal Leadership Group (ALG) convened its 24th meeting on 20-21 May 2026 to review progress, provide advice, and endorse key governance and delivery arrangements to support implementation of the Central Australia Plan (CAP) and improved outcomes for communities across Central Australia.

Key Outcomes

- **CAP Implementation**
The ALG received updates on progress across key CAP priority areas since the April 2026 meeting, including implementation tracking, investment by cluster, and the communications strategy.
- **Initiative Updates**
Members received updates and discussed key initiatives aimed at improving outcomes across Central Australia. These included sessions on:
 - Strengthening Families and Communities Partnership
 - Remote Training Hub Network and Mobile Training Units (MTUs)
 - Community Infrastructure Package
- **Strategic Investment and Alignment**
The Group participated in a workshop on the Northern Territory Remote Aboriginal Investment (NTRAI) in Central Australia, focusing on how the investment aligns with the Central Australia Plan. Members discussed key components, including the Alcohol Harm Reduction and Community Development schedules, and shared perspectives on priorities and alignment with local needs.
